The desert in Wickenburg is the most biologically diverse desert in the world. It offers riders the opportunity to ride next to giant Saguaro cacti, multiple species of desert trees and other plants like Ocotillo while getting the chance to see mule deer, coyotes and javelina. The ranch is surrounded by vast areas of public land and is near the Hassayampa River Wilderness area. The the Ranch's surrounding area has unlimited miles of trails to ride from the steep rocky canyons South of the ranch with fascinating geologic formations to sweeping vistas and the opportunity to ride in box canyon, one of only two places the Hassayampa river runs rear round. Riding to the North offers wide open trails with less rocky conditions crossing multiple washes large and small as you head toward the base of the Bradshaw mountains or into the Hassayampa River Wilderness area.

Sign up for this great opportunity to learn from one of the best in the industry. Chris Clark was the lead packer at the Grand Canyon for the Park Service for 9 years. He has years of experience in some of the toughest terrain there is.

He will be showing you how to **properly** pack up your animal with what you choose to take on an overnight stay that is safe and comfortable for your animal. Part of this will be on the trail experience, so you need to bring a riding animal and a pack animal. You will need to bring what you think you will need for a night out. He will demonstrate how to pack up and explain some techniques and hitches. He will go over proper saddle and bridle placement for the type of terrain you will be packing in. Next, you will be packing your animal with guidance from him. He will show you how to tie a hitch that you get to practice until you are comfortable with it. The next day, you will pack up your animal and we will all head out for a ride. This way if there is an issue on the trail, he is there to assist and give guidance on what to do. The goal is, at the end of the weekend, you will feel confident to pack up your animal and head out for an adventure!

This clinic will be right before the Boyd Ranch Mule Ride begins on Thursday. We will be offering an additional opportunity to go out on an overnight camp trip Wednesday night, returning Thursday. The cost will be \$200 and we will only take those clients that have gone through one of our clinics, for our safety and yours. If you are wanting to stay for the Mule Ride, you need to sign up with Scott Stewart. There is a separate cost for the ride that includes catered meals, silent auction, mule scramble and all kinds of good stuff so you might as well stay through the weekend!
